If you drive in
Aberdeen, Dundee,
Edinburgh or **Glasgow**
you'll need to know about
the Low Emission Zones
that were introduced
in May 2022.

LEZs set vehicle
emission standards
on certain road
spaces with the
aim of improving
air quality.

Older, more polluting vehicles that do not meet the proposed minimum emission standards will face a fine if they enter a LEZ when enforcement begins.

There will be a grace period before enforcement begins. Enforcement begins from 1 June 2023 in Glasgow (with an additional year for residents within the zone), from 30 May 2024 in Dundee and 1 June 2024 in Aberdeen and Edinburgh.
