Blue Badge Holders are exempt from Low Emission Zone restrictions.

Low Emission Zones encourage the use of cleaner vehicles.

Local grace periods now apply until enforcement begins.

Enforcement will begin in Glasgow on 1 June 2023, Dundee on 30 May 2024 and Aberdeen and Edinburgh on 1 June 2024.
