

LEZ Support Fund animation script

Low Emission Zones were introduced to Scotland's four largest cities in May 2022.

Glasgow's city centre LEZ enforcement has started.

When being driven in a Low Emission Zone vehicles must meet the LEZ minimum emission standards.

Vehicles that meet these standards pollute much less than those that do not.

You can check your vehicle now using the vehicle checker on our website.

Grace periods still apply in Aberdeen, Dundee and Edinburgh, which are set to begin LEZ enforcement in summer 2024.

Dundee will be enforced from the 30th of May 2024.

Aberdeen and Edinburgh will be enforced from the 1st of June 2024.

Support is available to help households meet LEZ requirements and travel more sustainably.

The Low Emission Zone Support Fund offers low-income households up to £3000 - £2,000 to incentivise disposal of a non-LEZ compliant vehicle plus up to two £500 Travel Better grants for two members of the householder to put towards the purchase a bike, an e-bike, share transport credits or public transport passes.

The Support Fund is means-tested and eligible applicants must live within a 20km radius of the LEZs in Aberdeen, Dundee, Edinburgh and Glasgow.
