


Vehicle retrofit webinars to help prepare for Scotland's Low Emission Zones

Low Emission Zones (LEZs), which set emission standards on certain road spaces, are expected to be introduced in Aberdeen, Dundee, Edinburgh and Glasgow by the end of May 2022.

The aim of LEZs is to improve air quality. Older, more polluting vehicles that do not meet the proposed minimum emission standards will face a penalty if they enter an LEZ.
